SOCIAL AND FUNDRAISING (SOFUN) 2023 ANNUAL REPORT

2023 EVENTS

In 2023 we held our first large-scale, open-to-the-public event in nearly a decade. Clofest 2023 was a festival of family fun that drew in crowds of over 3,000 people from the school community and local area. For the event, we had 32 sponsors, over 400 performers on the main stage and around 300 volunteers. The event raised approx \$45,000 to go towards a new playground.

There were a variety of other events throughout the year that engaged the school community, including an in-person Father's Day event that had high attendance. This year's Election BBQ & Sweet Stall was used to raise money for new sports equipment for the school.
